Subject: Mandatory Recycling Requirements for Sioux Falls Businesses

In an effort to extend the life of the Sioux Falls Regional Sanitary Landfill, the City of Sioux Falls has **mandatory recycling requirements** for waste haulers and Sioux Falls businesses.


The recycling requirements asked of licensed waste haulers and Sioux Falls residents are outlined in Chapter 57 of the Code of Ordinances of Sioux Falls, SD.

Per Section 57.028, commercial and business establishments, entertainment facilities, and schools shall separate from the waste stream all items excluded from disposal at the landfill as specified in Section 57.050 generated by or accruing to the establishments, prior to removal from the subject premises. The recyclable materials shall not be deposited at the sanitary landfill. Required recyclables include paper products, corrugated cardboard and chip board, plastic bottles, tubs, and jugs, and metal containers such as aluminum and tin cans. Per Section 57.030 (b) Nonresidential sites may use either single-stream, dual-stream or source separated methodology for the collection and management of recyclable materials. If your business chooses to self-haul recyclable materials, you are required to report the weight of any recyclable materials hauled, transferred, or recycled by self or others to your garbage hauler for use by the garbage hauler to account for recyclable materials under Section 57.031.

For your reference, a recycling guide has been enclosed. The green side includes materials that may be accepted in your single-stream recycling container, and the red side shows items that should not be placed in your single-stream recycling bin. I have also included a Business Self-Shipped form for reporting of self-hauled recyclables to your waste hauler.
